How to Participate

Early-bird registration is optional and begins on Friday, June 6. You will receive a summer event calendar, a detailed brochure and a Summer Kickoff activity sheet. Complete the activity sheet and return it beginning Friday, June 13 in order to receive your first weekly reading record.

Registration for the Summer Reading Challenge officially begins on Friday, June 13 and will continue through the month of June. You will receive a summer event calendar, a detailed brochure and your first weekly reading record. Attend any of the free programs that interest you and your family. Programs marked with a red asterisk* require online registration, which is available on the Programs & Events page of the library's website at www.waterford.lib.wi.us. Stop in once a week to turn in your child's reading record and they'll receive a prize, a grand prize drawing slip and a new reading record for the following week. *All ages are welcome to participate, even adults and those too young to read on their own.* There are no residency requirements to participate.



Completing your Reading Record in a Nutshell...

- ⇒ Mark off six items on the weekly reading record bookmark.
- ⇒ Bring the bookmark to the library and turn it in for the next week's bookmark. You will receive a small prize and fill out a grand prize drawing slip for each week you complete.

Notes for Teens

- ✓ Teens can participate in the Summer Reading Challenge by completing activities on a weekly Bingo sheet. Turn in your sheet each week for a small prize, a grand prize drawing slip and the next week's Bingo sheet.
- ✓ Teens entering eighth grade through twelfth grade are eligible to volunteer at the library. A sign-up sheet is available at the Children's Circulation Desk. Teen volunteers will receive a grand prize drawing slip for each hour they volunteer.



For Adults

Adults can participate in the Summer Reading Challenge by completing activities listed on the Adult Summer Reading Challenge sheet. Ask for one at the registration table or information desk. Complete at least four activities to earn a prize and a grand prize drawing slip!

Grand Prize Drawings

Children and teens participating in the Summer Reading Challenge will receive a grand prize drawing slip for each week they complete. Participating adults will receive a grand prize drawing slip for every four activities completed on the adult challenge sheet. Reading record sheets must be turned in by July 19. Drawings will be held the week of July 21 and winners will be notified by phone.
