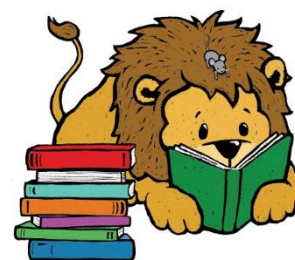


2021 Summer Reading Challenge Tails & Tales @ Waterford Library

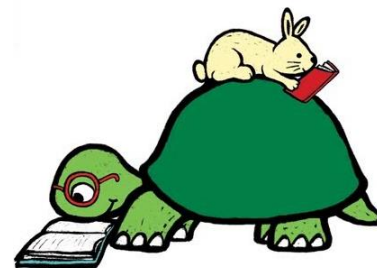


How to Participate

The Summer Reading Challenge begins Friday, June 11. You can register online through Beanstack using the link on our website at www.waterford.lib.wi.us or download the Beanstack app. Everyone is welcome to participate, even those too young to read. Keep track of your reading through Beanstack, or earn Book Bucks by checking out materials at the Waterford Library. A combination of in-person and take-home programs are available all summer. Attend any of the free programs that interest you and your family. Families do not have to be registered in Beanstack to join in-person programming or to earn Book Bucks. Face coverings and social distancing may be encouraged or required depending on current state and local mandates and at the discretion of the Library Board. How to Win Prizes

All ages, children and adults, are invited to participate in the Summer Reading Challenge. Each week, everyone who is registered can earn a grand prize drawing ticket for reading (or being read to), or by participating in challenges throughout the summer. Families who are registered online, or with the app, can enter the grand prize drawings through their Beanstack account. Tweens and teens can earn tickets for participating with Beanstack or earn drawing slips to win a VISA gift card by volunteering in-person or at home. All volunteer hours must be approved and recorded to earn prize slips.



How to Earn and Spend Book Bucks

Book Bucks are earned by checking out materials at the Waterford Library. Collect them June 11 – July 19. Stop by the library during special Summer Reading Prize Store hours to spend them.
